

Dental Implant Appointment Checklist



Things to bring to your appointment:

- Insurance and prescription cards
- Names and doses of medication
- History of previous medical/dental conditions and operations
- A list of questions you would like to ask your dentist. These could include:
 1. I have missing teeth. What are my options for replacement?
 2. My dentures are uncomfortable and don't fit properly. What can you do to help?
 3. Can you tell me more about dental implants and how they are different from conventional bridges and dentures?
 4. Am I a candidate for an implant supported bridge or implant supported dentures?
 5. What are the benefits of an implant supported bridge or denture?
 6. How long does the process take?
 7. Will I have to be without my bridge or dentures during the process?
 8. How will my oral hygiene change if I opt to get an implant supported bridge or implant supported dentures?
 9. What is the cost?
 10. Are there any side effects?
